Registration

Relay Team Full Marathon

Runners/walkers are responsible for their own transportation to and from their start and finish points. Minimum of 2 persons on a team, choose your own distances to cover the full marathon distance.

Water & Refreshments

Water stations throughout route and approximately every 3k. Refreshments at the finish line.

Facilities

Portable toilets are available on the route.

Prizes/Awards

Awards for different male and female categories and many draw prizes. Being a major fundraising event we have chosen to keep costs at a minimum, therefore there will not be race medals. We realize this is disappointing for some however the cost incurred is significant and the monies saved are contributed to the fund.

Important: The 10k, half and full events are for individuals over the age of 12. The 5k is for all ages but children age 12 and under must be accompanied on the run by an adult. Participants are invited to run and/or walk. No wheels allowed (i.e. strollers, bicycles, etc) and no dogs permitted on the course.

The Virtual Run (or walk): If you aren't able to attend in person, just register for the distance you'd like to do, get a shirt (if registered by the deadline of April 1st 2020) and run your event from home, on a treadmill, outside, at your own pace from anywhere in the country...or the world!

Course Description

This route is by far the freshest, most scenic and beautiful route in Yarmouth County. The route is relatively flat with a few small hills and will be well marked. All runners will head out on the same route toward the Yarmouth Lighthouse along the picturesque Lighthouse Route. The route is along the back of Yarmouth harbour.

5K - turn at the designated mark on the Grove Rd

10k - turn around at the designated 5k mark just past the Overton ball field.

Half - will pass the Fishermen's Monument and go through the small fishing village of John's Cove, past John's Cove beach to the turn-around at the lighthouse and will return along the same route to finish on a hill (Hibernia Street) leading to NSCC Burrige.

Full - follow the same route as the half and turn around on Vancouver St and run back to the lighthouse and return to town (2 loops). Once back on Vancouver St runners will finish by going south on Main St, turn left on to Herbert St, up to Pleasant St and turn left to finish at NSCC Burrige.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All runners must present themselves to check-in/ registration at Burrige Campus on Sunday May 3rd 2020.
- All runners start at the same time and location on Main Street (see start line information).
- All runners finish on a hill (Hibernia Street) leading to Burrige Campus with the exception of the full marathon and relay teams.
- Support is available for 5 hours after the start. After 1 pm all remaining runners will be given a reasonable chance to finish the marathon with minimal support and traffic control.
